• **TWO QUESTIONS DETERMINE YOUR PEACE**

- I) WHO _____ YOUR LIFE?
- A) Government, *MISRAH* (HEB), ‘government, dominion’.
- B) “Prince of Peace” v.6
Prince, *SAR* (HEB), ‘Chief, Ruler, Lord’. Prov.8:16; Dan. 10:13,20,21; Rev. 1:5
The Son comes to sit on a throne.
Gen.14:18 (King of Peace); Isaiah 48:18, 22; 54:13; 32:17; Ps. 119:165; * Acts 10:36; Rom. 14:17; Phil. 2:10,11; Rev. 4:8-11; Rev. 7:14-17
- II) WHO _____ YOUR _____ ?

Shoulder, *SHKEM* (HEB), ‘the neck, as the place of burdens’. From *SHAKAM* (HEB), ‘to incline to a burden, to be loaded up’. Picture an animal kneeling or lowering itself (like a camel) to be loaded, to have burdens placed upon it. See Isaiah 9:4; 10:27; 14:25; 22:22-25; Psalm 81:6; Gen.24:14,15,45.

This word *SHAKAM* is also translated 56 times to rise, arose, or some form of to raise or be raised. This word captures the whole process of an animal lowering to be loaded up with burdens, then rising to carry them away.

See the Scapegoat in Lev. 16:7-10, 21,22 and Isaiah 53:6.

MARBEH, (HEB), ‘to continue to enlarge, multiply’. From *RABAB* (HEB), ‘to cause to make abundant’. *Isaiah 6:1, “His train filled the temple...”; Dan.4:1; 6:25; 2 Pet.1:2; 1 Pet.1:2.
